Decisions Made in Communion with the Holy Spirit

Today's Gospel addresses the final words of Jesus at the Last Supper. They are considered His will to His disciples. He announced that He was going back to the Father soon and they should rejoice because those who love Him would one day join Him. Jesus is aware of the tribulations His apostles would face; however He leaves His peace with them. His peace comes not as the world gives it, through domination and oppression, but through freedom and forgiveness.

Then an important promise was made to the disciples, "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." From its very early days, the Christian community believed in the presence of the Holy Spirit among them. Every decision was made under His guidance who led them to proclaim the Word of Jesus.

In the First Reading, the apostles realized that the Gentiles should not be burdened with the old law of circumcision. This law was not essential for their salvation. The apostles wrote to the Gentiles: "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and ours." In their understanding, the Crucified and Risen Lord, whom the Gentiles accepted as their Saviour, has set them free and brought them to the light. Now, all they need to do is to avoid what is impure.

As members of the Church of Jesus we also should ask ourselves whether or not His Spirit leads us. Do we ask the Holy Spirit's guidance for our decisions? Remember, He is given to everyone and teaches the disciples of Jesus the will of God.
