#### Pentecost Sunday



Today we celebrate the mystery of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Mary and the Apostles. He was sent by Jesus as He had promised at the Last Supper.

Now the Holy Spirit keeps Jesus' disciples bonded as one body and, at the same time, sends them to announce the Good News throughout the world. The Holy Spirit is dynamic and inspires various gifts and ministries for the edification of all. A great gift has come to the early Church on the day of Pentecost.

The Bible says that the Spirit of God came in tongues of fire and reposed on those who were locked inside the house. After this event, a great transformation happened in their lives. The frightened disciples became courageous witnesses of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord. They were able to proclaim this message in different languages so that every person could understand it. As the Apostles were empowered with the strength of the Holy Spirit they opened their doors and went out to proclaim that Jesus is alive.

Pentecost is the Solemnity that concludes the Easter Season. Next Sunday, the Church will celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity and continue the Ordinary Time until the Feast of Christ the King. This way the liturgy reminds us that, through the power of the Holy Spirit received in our Baptism, God is always with us and never ceases to act in the simplicity of our daily lives.
