Keep and Spread His Word

The Gospel for the sixth Sunday of Easter speaks of the essential message of Jesus' earthly ministry: love. Last Sunday, Jesus bid His disciples to love one another as He has loved them. In the same Gospel, John the Evangelist records one of the last messages of Jesus before His Ascension into heaven. Here, Jesus reassures His friends that they will not be left orphans. He will continue to be with them and guide them as they continue the mission He has begun. This will be fulfilled in and through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, whom He will send as the "Paraclete," a guide, a counselor who will teach them all things, and remind them all that Jesus had said to them.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the disciples will preach the Good News of the Kingdom to the ends of the earth. They will tell the world about the love of God in Jesus Christ. You and I continue the work of the apostles. We are modern-day apostles of Jesus Christ. Jesus speaks to us through our liturgy and urges us with the same message He gave to His disciples 2,000 years ago: "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him."

The love of Jesus urges us to do what God wants us to do. This love, however, is not "one way." For if we love God and obey His will, peace will be upon us. This peace, which the world cannot offer, will bring us lasting happiness. Therefore, as the Scripture says, we must obey God rather than humans. If we do this, we shall inherit the fullness of God's blessings.

Our reflection is: how do we keep Jesus' word in our daily lives? And as we know, that in modern society secularism and consumerism become the way of our lives. So how can we, who believe to Jesus, spread the Good News and share our faith with others?


