

Holy Trinity, A Mystery of Love

Today we gather to celebrate the great mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, one God revealed in three different persons, the Father our Creator, the Son our Redeemer and the Holy Spirit our Sanctifier. Indeed, they are perfectly united through the power of love. The Holy Trinity shows us that God is not a lonely being; Father, Son and Holy Spirit are in constant relationship and the three together make the perfect community: a sign and icon for our earthly communities that strive to become one body in Christ.

We can compare it to lighting three candles, putting them together and uniting their flames. The three flames become one fire with a stronger light and warmth so that you cannot distinguish between them anymore. God is one fire of love and this same love is found equally in all the three persons of the Holy Trinity. Therefore, Love is the fire that forges and merges the three divine Persons as it does in the Church to create unity among us.

In today's gospel Jesus is about to ascend to the Father's right hand. Before this takes place, He commissions His apostles with the task of making disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. On the day of our baptism we welcomed within us the heavenly presence of the Holy Trinity. We have become God's dwelling place through love and faith. We cannot forget that we are God's living temple and together we form one Body united in the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear parishioners,

With these words of the prophet Isaiah I wish to give thanks to God for my fruitful time of service to our vibrant parish community. We have received communication from the Archdiocese of Toronto that Cardinal Collins has appointed Rev. Aegidius Warsito, SCJ, as pastor of St. Thomas More and Our Lady of the Rosary Parishes. Effective June 1, 2018, I conclude my term as the priest responsible for our parish community. The new pastoral team will be formed by, Fr. Warsito, along with Fr. Martin Anthony Kadamattu, SCJ, originally from India, and Fr. Antonio Resende Pereira, SCJ, a newly ordained priest from Brazil. Both arrived in Toronto in March and have already been involved with our pastoral activities.
