He is the Door to Life

Today's gospel speaks about the relationship between the shepherd and his sheep. They know each other intimately, to the point of recognizing the shepherd's voice and following him without reservation. As a result of their trust. the sheep are led to green pastures with plenty of food and abundance of life. On the other hand. Jesus talks about thieves and bandits who come to destroy. They invade the flock in order to scatter the sheep.

This parable shows a reality in Jesus' time when many false prophets exploited the poor for their own benefit. We are called not only to warn people of the constant risk of being lured by untrue promises and evil attempts but also to defend them from the snares of their enemies. Jesus is clear; the sheep should not follow a stranger, since they will run away for they do not know his voice.

As Christians who follow the shepherd's voice we need to stand for those who are vulnerable and often become victims of the malice of the powerful. We need to defend life as a valuable gift of God that must never be disrespected or manipulated.

Let us proclaim that Jesus is the door. He alone can lead us to life for He first suffered and endured the cruelty of the cross. He paid the price of our salvation. As Peter says in the First Reading, "by his wounds you have been healed.'
