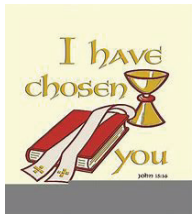

A Call to be a Priest



This Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Easter, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday, and the Church invites all of us to think about the vocation to be a priest in the Church.

Jesus founded the Church, and along with it the priesthood, so that there would be a continual offering of the Mass in His memory. Jesus is calling those He has chosen, but are they hearing His voice? And are we helping those that Jesus has chosen to hear His voice?

Jesus is indeed calling, but another voice is being heard and it's calling out for "someone else", as in "let someone else be a priest, but not me," or "let someone else join the Church ministry, but not me."

The voice of Jesus is calling out to us. If we don't listen, then there will be no one else who will join the priesthood. If we don't listen to the voice of Jesus, then no one else will pray for vocations to the priesthood. If we don't listen to the voice of Jesus, then it will be time to write an obituary and it will be an obituary about our Church. But when we listen to the voice of Jesus, then the parish will bear fruit – prayers will be answered, miracles will happen, nothing will be impossible and there will be vocations to the priesthood, as well as to the religious life.

Our question is: do we listen to the voice of Jesus? What will we do to increase vocations to the priesthood in our parish?
