The Ten Bridesmaids

In today's Gospel Jesus tells us the parable of the ten bridesmaids as they go to meet the bridegroom and take part in the wedding banquet. Once again the Kingdom of God is compared to a great feast to which everyone is invited. As in other parables, Jesus evokes the need of being prepared. The bridegroom will come at an unexpected time and those who are not ready to meet him will not enter the banquet.

The parable speaks about ten bridesmaids; five were wise and brought extra oil for their lamps, five were foolish and did not have sufficient oil for the whole night. All of them are asleep when suddenly a shout is heard; "Look! Here is the bridegroom!" Now, it is too late to find oil for their lamps and the foolish will not enjoy the presence of the bridegroom.

Even though the five wise bridesmaids seem to be greedy and selfish for refusing to share their oil, the parable talks about a "fuel" that cannot be given to others. Jesus is the bridegroom and when He comes each of us will meet Him with the faith and love that we personally cultivate in our lifetime. As St. Paul says to the Thessalonians, Jesus will come with a cry of command, with the sound of God's trumpet and we will face Him the way we are, with no deceit.

This call is urgent! Get rid of all foolishness and be vigilant! Do not wait any longer for it might be too late. The First Reading says; "Wisdom is easily discerned by those who love her and is found by those who seek her." Let us embrace God's wisdom and be prepared for when His Son comes in glory.


