The End Times

St. Vincent de Paul Society

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus talks about the signs of 'end-times': wars, earthquakes, plagues, famines and insurrections. Jesus also warns about the appearance of false prophets who will come in His name. Finally, Jesus warns us that His followers will be persecuted. Through it all, Jesus instructs us: "do not be afraid, do not be deceived, and do not give up."

Fear is one of the greatest instruments of the evil one and his agents. How often have people been silenced because of fear? How often has the work of God been aborted because of fear, real or imagined? The Lord tells us today to be courageous! Another instrument used by the evil one and his trusted agents in this world is untruthfulness. So, what do we supposed to do? We need to listen to God in these trying times. In the Gospels, God says things such as, "All things are possible," "I will give you rest," "I love you," "I can do all things," "I will never leave nor forsake you," "I have not given you a spirit of fear," and so on. We need to be courageous when we encounter all sorts of lies and intimidation. There will be problems, there will be pain, and even persecutions. Through it all, we must be joyful and strong. Therefore, may our faith strengthen us and enable us to withstand all the pressures and attacks of the evil one and his trusted agents. And let us once more listen to Jesus' words in today's Gospel: "You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair of your head will parish. By your endurance you will gain your souls."

Our reflection is: what sort of fears haunt and affect us? Are we paralyzed by our fears? What will we do to prepare ourselves at the end times?


