The King of Mercy

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King and the closing of the Jubilee Year of Mercy. We are invited to give thanks to God for His tenderness and reflect on Jesus' kingship. He was not made king in a palace, holding treasures of gold, privileges and power. Rather, our Lord was born in a manger, lived in poverty and died between thieves, with no place to lay His head. He revealed to us the merciful face of God as He became close to each of us. He proclaimed mercy as a beatitude as He said, "blessed are the merciful for they shall see mercv."

The liturgy reminds us that Jesus, the King of the Universe, was crowned with a crown of thorns. On Calvary He was stripped of all His vestments and gave His life on the cross, which became His throne. Those who maltreated Him questioned His power asking Him to save Himself. For the repented thief, though, He granted forgiveness promising him paradise. As a sign of scorn they called Jesus "King of the Jews"; He responded to all humiliation with love and mercy.

So today we profess that Jesus is King of the Universe. As no other king in human history, He endured suffering and death to become the Ruler of Heaven and Earth. His kingdom is of mercy and love. We bow down before Him in adoration for He is divine! He is the king of mercy who came to save us, died and rose from the dead, is now seated at the right hand of the Father and will come again in glory to fulfill His work of mercy. Fr. Will, SCJ
