# A King in Poverty

As we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King we consider Jesus' kingship. He was not made a king in a palace, with treasures of gold, privileges and power. Our Lord was born in a manger, lived in poverty and died between thieves, with no place to lay His head. He proclaimed poverty as a beatitude and said "blessed are the poor in spirit for they shall inherit the Kingdom of Heaven." (Matthew 5:3)

Jesus, the King of the Universe, was crowned with a crown of thorns. In Calvary He was stripped of all His vestments and gave His life on the cross, which became His throne. So it is very appropriate that the Gospel of this Liturgy reminds us of the time of Jesus' trial. Pontius Pilate interrogated Him about His royalty and He revealed that His Kingdom is not from this world. The Kingdom of God is beyond any earthly comparison; it is much greater than our political structures. It is a reign of love, peace and justice that begins here as we follow the Gospel of Jesus, but will be fulfilled in heaven.

Today we profess that Jesus is King of the Universe. As no other king in human history, He endured suffering and death to become the Ruler of Heaven and Earth. We bow down before Him in adoration for He is divine! He is the king in poverty who rose from the dead, is seated at the right hand of the Father and will come again in glory.
