#### Christ, the King of All

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King and the conclusion of our liturgical year. Jesus, King of the Universe, is the foundation of our hope, faith and love. Every time we serve the least of our brothers and sisters it is Jesus to whom we dedicate our fraternal charity. In fact, this will be the criteria that our Lord will apply at our last judgment when He appears in glory. Christ will say to the saved; "I was hungry, thirsty, a stranger, naked, sick and a prisoner and you cared for me. Come, you blessed of my Father, and inherit the Kingdom prepared for you". On the other hand, those who disregarded them will not inherit God's Kingdom.

It is not easy to see Jesus in the poor and marginalized. Their appearance is not attractive and it often causes repulse. We have to admit that most Christians feel more comfortable in meeting Jesus in the Church, through prayers and in the Eucharist. We forget though that Jesus is in the poor as much as He is in the Blessed Sacrament. Our participation in His Heavenly Banquet is a commitment to love and serve others just as we have been loved and served by the Lord at His table. It is indeed our concrete response of love that will not be ignored by Christ when we see Him face to face; "Just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me".

What kind of Kingdom did Jesus announce? Was it not a Kingdom where every human person has dignity? Was it not a Kingdom of peace, love, respect and justice for all? Yes, our Lord lived, died and rose again to for this Kingdom. He also counts on us to help Him establish this reality among us. To be part of God's Kingdom we need to recognize each other as brothers and sisters, beginning from the least who are excluded and rejected. By doing so, we will honour Christ, King of the Universe, for He does not forsake any of the little ones who are victims of social injustice and poverty. His life was totally given to them, and so is His Kingdom.


