

They Don't Practice What They Teach

The conflict between Jesus and the religious authorities of His time has reached the highest point. Now Jesus exposes their desire of privileges and prestige. He also teaches the crowds and His disciples not to follow the example of the Pharisees for "they do not practice what they teach." Instead, Jesus proposes a community of brothers and sisters who serve each other in a spirit of love and humbleness. "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

In the First Reading the Prophet Malachi denounces a similar situation. After the exile in Babylon, God's people have come back to the Promised Land where the temple has been reconstructed. However the priests became involved in corruption and led many to stumble. The prophet warns them that God will show His justice by "making them despised and abased before all people." We cannot forget that every action brings consequences and that we will be found accountable for misusing God's gifts.

A bad example should not be followed! Rather, it should help us learn what should not be done. Beware of those who are able to speak beautifully but do not make an effort to put their words into practice. They seek recognition of others but are dishonest and deceitful. We are called to be humble servants inspired by the words of Paul to the Thessalonians; "we care so deeply that we are determined to share with you not only the Gospel of God but also our own selves." Let's try our best to teach what we believe and to live what we teach. *Fr. Willyans, SCJ*
