# Info for all Ministry and Group Leaders

The Archdiocese of Toronto has a procedure called "Strengthening the Caring Community" in place to ensure the safety of parishioners. Everyone who is serving in a volunteer capacity in all of our parishes is required to fill out and hand in a Volunteer Information Form. As well, volunteers who are working with or want to work with vulnerable persons in such positions as teaching or working with children and young people or taking Holy Communion to homebound parishioners are required to (1) give the names of three references (friends, co-workers and/or relatives) who will be asked to fill out a two-page reference form, (2) have an interview, and (3) give permission to undergo a security check. The members of the Screening Committee handle most of the details, but the leaders of the various ministries are the first contacts.
