#### To be Grateful to God

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus performs a miracle by curing 10 lepers. Leprosy, at that time, was possibly the worst affliction a family could endure. Lepers were ostracized from the entire community and had to stay away from any contact with healthy individuals because the disease was very contagious. These lepers had to leave their wives, children and friends. They had to leave the village and lead a life of loneliness, waiting for their death.

Being cured of leprosy would be the greatest gift a person could receive. There was no cure, no hope. Therefore, every leper who had been cured would seek out Jesus and thank Him profusely. He had allowed them to return to their wives and their children. He made it possible for them to mingle with their friends and neighbours in the village. Not only that, but He lengthened their life span by many years. But only one man returned to thank Jesus. Jesus Himself was stunned: *"Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they?"* 

So, what is the message for us today?

We should be thankful for God's gifts to us. There are many reasons for us to be thankful. I think it would be proper to say that even the poorest of us have been blessed by God. Some of us might say, "We don't have a million dollars in the bank, and we don't have some of the luxuries others have." That's true! However, most of the world's population has far fewer blessings than we enjoy. Most of us are well fed. We live in relative safety and have excellent health programs. We have to admit, "God has blessed all of us and, individually, that's why we should say Thank You to Him." And if Jesus were here today, I believe He would say to us what He said to the crowd, "You have been (cleansed) blessed. All I ask is that you recognize what you have been given and be grateful for the gifts."

So, how can we be grateful? And Jesus will say: "Love one another as I have loved you!"

Hopefully this Gospel helps us to be a better disciple of Jesus. *Fr. Aegi, SCJ*
