Perseverance

This Sunday's Gospel is about how we can learn about perseverance. Jesus asks all of us to be steadfast in prayer. He asks us to persevere in our faith. This is not an easy thing to do. There are lots of things to distract us from being faithful, faith filled and prayerful. There are things that happen day in and day out that make it hard to be loving or forgiving and understanding. Jesus asks us to be wary of all of these situations.

When we get involved with long term problems or are asked to live daily with difficulties that last a long time, it's easy to get weary and tired. As a matter of fact, it's a natural reaction to feel like giving in and quitting. We get distracted and lose focus. The only thing we can do when we are involved in long term situations is to remember this Gospel. The woman persevered and, finally, the judge granted her request. She was like a marathon runner. She paced herself and never got tired or distracted from her goal. She never quit.

When we are involved in long term situations, Jesus is asking us to remain steadfast in our faith, in being hopeful, in loving, sharing and being committed to Christ here on earth. He gave us examples from His own life so that we would know how to accomplish His commands.

Today, Jesus is asking us to persevere in our faith, in truly loving our neighbour and in keeping His commandments. And hopefully with this Gospel, we can learn to persevere.

Our reflection is: when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on earth?

Will He find people who persevere in loving their God?
