True Follower of Jesus

In this Sunday's Gospel, it tells us that James and John came and asked Jesus: *"Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you. Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory."* They were thinking of a promotion. They were thinking that they have the ability, the capacity and worthiness for this.

Jesus' reaction was: "You do not know what you are asking for." Instead of talking about glory and happiness, Jesus talked to them about sharing His "cup" and "baptism." The cup had been the biblical symbol of great suffering, while baptism signifies overwhelming sorrow and pain. This is what it means to be a true follower of Jesus.

Today, Jesus reminds all of us to be His true disciples: "we have to serve the rest," and meet the needs of others. Jesus' whole life was one of service. If we want to be the number one person in the Christian community then we must be at the service of all just like Church workers are doing. I'm sure you experienced this yourself that there are people we could not forget because of what he/she did, not only heroes, martyrs, and saints but also ordinary people.

So, our reflection is: are we willing to go through and to live what Jesus is saying: *"Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant?"* What are we looking for?
