Faith and Act

In this Sunday's Gospel, we read that the disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith. This was because they had experienced their share of failures and were now being sent out like lambs among wolves. But Jesus replied, "If you had faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, be uprooted and planted in the sea, and it would obey you."

A mustard seed is the smallest seed of all and can reach a height of 3-4 meters when it grows up. Sycamore is the hardest wood and lasts for 600 years. Jesus uses this image to show the kind of faith He wants from us.

This passage also talks about our attitude towards our faith. This attitude has to be acted upon, as stated in the second part of the Gospel - the parable of the worthless slaves.

What should be the attitude of a Christian towards his or her faith in God?

Does it mean going to Mass every Sunday, praying the Rosary and spending time in Adoration every day?

Does it mean sharing in the one Faith, one Baptism and one Lord?

Does it mean knowing the Apostles' Creed, believing the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and believing in a Trinitarian God?

Yes, but more than these. A Christian should be known not only by his or her attitude towards their faith but most especially on how he or she acts upon this faith through loving service to others.

Therefore, our reflection is: How do we profess our identity as a Catholic in our daily lives?

How can we live out our faith in Jesus in the context of modern society today?


