#### **Salvation Has Come to This House**


Jericho is Jesus' last stop on the way to Jerusalem. On this long journey He met several people; some acknowledge Him as the Messiah and followed Him on the way but others refused His message of peace and justice beyond the Law, as well as His gestures of love and compassion for the marginalized. In Jericho Jesus encounters Zacchaeus, a hated tax collector. This encounter becomes an example of the mercy of God that touches every sinner.

In the midst of the crowd, Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus but he was too short. A sycamore tree was the solution. He climbed it and waited for Jesus to pass by. He had probably heard about Jesus but had not met Him. Yet Jesus knew and called him by name; "Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today." Other citizens criticized Jesus for staying with a sinner, especially one who became rich by exploiting the poor. But Zacchaeus was happy to confirm that what he heard was true: Jesus is merciful!

"Today salvation has come to this house", said Jesus as Zacchaeus promises to repay those whom he had defrauded. His conversion is demonstrated by his decision to make amends. Jesus did not ask him to do anything, but Zacchaeus' conscience led him to repair the harm he had caused. Salvation is truly universal! It came to Zacchaeus who had been a slave of money and to the poor who had been exploited. *Fr. Will, SCJ*
