#### **Being Humble**

Welcome back! Summer holidays are over. Hopefully this summer holiday brought us new energy and spirit. Our first parish bulletin will focus on the need to be humble.

The word "humility" comes from the Latin word "humus" which means ground. So, one who is humble is grounded. They are grounded in reality. That is why we must be careful and avoid false humility, that is, of being falsely grounded in perceived reality. Humility here would be the awareness of who they really are in relationship with the other "guests". And to be humble is to recognize, acknowledge, accept, and live in accordance with that reality. It is a reality that we can't live without God's help.

It means that the humble person doesn't need titles and positions to maintain a sense of their dignity. They don't need those things. They don't rely on those things for a sense of who they really are. The humble person may have a title, or a position or whatever it may be, but they don't need and require that title. They don't need the best seat in the house to maintain their dignity. All they truly need is to know that they are a child and friend of the living God.

The humble person also notices other people. The humble person treats with care those who, very often, can do them little or no good; those whom he might otherwise never notice. Lastly, the humble person leads and does so by serving quietly. They get on with what needs to be done, to touch and influence for good, the lives of others.

When Jesus was about to go to the cross and the disciples were trying to decide who among them is the greatest, Jesus quietly tells them that He is their leader and He demonstrates leadership as one who serves. So, humility is not passivity, not the lack of assertiveness. Sometimes humble people are very assertive on behalf of others.

Our reflection is: are we humble enough? What should we do to be a humble person like Jesus?


