The Parables of Mercy

The lost sheep, the lost coin and the prodigal son... We all know these parables in today's Gospel. They bring us a deep sense of caring and mercy as the shepherd, the woman and the father lose and then search for something or someone immensely valuable. The preciousness of the loss is so great that they feel compelled to search for and retrieve them. The shepherd leaves ninety-nine sheep behind and goes after the lost one; the woman lights a lamp, sweeps the house and searches carefully for her coin; and the merciful father, full of love and compassion, runs to his son as soon as he sees him from afar.

People tend to identify themselves with the object, animal or lost person of these parables. Many times we see ourselves as the prodigal son who wasted his father's inheritance and later repented and returned; or even as the older son who judged his brother and did not accept him back. Ironically both were lost and needed to be found. As with the lost sheep, the prodigal son was lost outside the house; they were far from their loving father and shepherd. The older son, however, like the woman's lost coin, was lost inside the house. He was protected by his father's affection and still did not understand that love is also forgiveness.

No matter what situation we are at we always need to be found. I have seen several people who often come to the church, but are still lost in the House of the Lord. They did not find their place yet. Others rebelliously went away to live their dreams and abandoned the Father. Nevertheless, we have a Merciful Father and today He wants to find us and celebrate our return. He is at the centre of these Parables of Mercy. Let us come back and be reconciled with Him.


Sponsoring Refugees
