#### Money

Again, in this Sunday's Gospel Jesus teaches His disciples with a parable about a dishonest steward. In this Gospel, Jesus gives just one indication of what can go wrong to people, organizations, and even to nations. And that indication is what is often called "the root of all evil." It is none other than the love of or the obsession with money and worldly riches.

Jesus gave this teaching which is often not heeded: "No slave can serve two masters. For a slave will either hate the one and love the other or be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth."

Jesus goes on to say: "Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. If then you have not been faithful with dishonest wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches?"

This teaching of Jesus reminds us that having money is not a sin. We use it for daily necessities and to get on in life. But it is the love and obsession for money that will separate us from God and from loving Him alone. That is why sometimes we have difficulty to see the needs of others or we don't have enough time to just sit and talk with family, friends and even with God. Because we have a tendency to never be satisfied with the money that we have.

So, money is just that little thing that we can be trusted with and should be trusted with. But Jesus has entrusted us with something much greater, in fact, a genuine treasure.

Our reflection is: how can we get rid of the love and obsession for money? How can we use the money that we have to glorify God in our daily lives?


