#### **God in our Lives**

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus talks about the rich man and Lazarus. The story begins with the lives of the two men on earth. The rich man had all the luxuries of life: good food, clothing, housing and even good health and he was enjoying himself. At the gate of his house, lay a man named Lazarus. He was hungry, dirty, and sickly. Dogs came to lick his sores, not to comfort him, but because he was too weak to chase them away.

Then both of them died and experienced a reversal of fortunes in the afterlife. Lazarus was carried by the angels to the bosom of Abraham, while the rich man cried out in agony in flames. He was burning in pain in a fire that did not go out. Although it was a reversal of fortunes, the point of the story is not that the poor will go to heaven while the rich will be damned. Whether rich or poor, the bigger question is about the importance of God in their lives.

For the rich man, luxury was his god. He loved his luxuries, and he used these only for himself. He knew that Lazarus was at his gate, but cared nothing for him. It was all about himself, and his life was only about "me, myself and I". Therefore, in the afterlife he suffered. Lazarus may be among the poorest of the poor, but his name gives us an indication of the importance of God in his life. His name, Lazarus, means "God-is-my-helper". That tells us that despite his poverty, he still looked to God for help and was finally comforted with an everlasting reward.

Our reflection is: How about us? Where is God in our Lives?

Can we truly say that God is our helper?


