Being Followers of Jesus

In Sunday's Gospel this week, John and his companion-apostles met a man they did not know who expelled demons in Jesus' name. How dare this outsider make use of His name? So they stopped him because he was not a member of their group and to end a flagrant malpractice.

Actually, this Gospel passage deals with the issue of membership in the Church. In the early Church, the question arose as to what to do about those good people who were not disciples of Jesus. This is still a question for us today. Can people who do not believe in God or who belong to a non-Christian religion or a Christian be saved? Can a Christian Catholic who does not participate in the sacramental life and religious activities of the Church be still called a Catholic?

St. Mark, in this Sunday's Gospel, gives an answer to this question. For those people who are not members of this Christian community or who do not follow Jesus, Mark tells us that Jesus appreciates all the good that was done by these people and does not reject them. He even says, "Whoever gives you a cup of water to drink because you bear the name of Christ will by no means lose the reward."

But this is not an excuse for us to not do our part as Christians. St. Mark says, that Jesus is demanding of people who claim to be His followers, including ourselves. Jesus says: "If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life maimed than to have two hands to go to hell." and so on.

So for all followers, Jesus demands no compromise, no easy-going attitude in judgment and practice.

Can we still call ourselves disciples of Jesus?
