#### "He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak"

The prophecy of Isaiah foretold the coming of Jesus. God had made a promise of salvation that would come true with the arrival of the Messiah, His Anointed One. People would see the signs of this new time: the blind would see, the deaf would hear, the lame would leap, the mute would sing and water would flow abundantly in dry land.

By healing the deaf-mute man, Jesus reveals Himself as the promised Messiah. "Ephphatha" said Jesus, "Be opened", as He spit and touched the man's tongue. Everyone was amazed at His deeds of power and they went to spread the news about Him. But He wanted them to tell no one. This secrecy about Jesus' miracles is precisely because there is more to be revealed. The Messiah is the Son of God who will give Himself up on the cross and thus fully accomplish his work of salvation.

So the Lord wants us to understand that being His followers is about giving ourselves up to sacrifice of love. St. James exhorted his community to love the rich and the poor, without making any distinction. Today we ask Jesus to open our ears, mouths and hearts to embrace His word and not just seek miracles but strive to alleviate the suffering of others.
