Discipleship

In today's Gospel Jesus spells out in clear terms who cannot be His disciple: *"Whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple."* In other words, those who do not make a clear and firm decision to follow Him should just play outside.

Who's in? One who is willing to leave family and loved ones is "in." One who is willing to give up all their possessions is also "in." Discipleship means following the Master and putting the Master's agenda above one's personal agenda.

Who's out? One who cannot decide, and one who takes the road of compromise is **"out."** Whoever wants to follow the Master must follow Him freely, firmly and clearly. Jesus does not want undecided, half-hearted and half-committed disciples. Why?

Because *discipleship involves sacrifice*. It means giving up beloved people and cherished things for the sake of something or someone greater. *Discipleship involves obedience, too*. Those who follow the Master must be willing to obey Him and His marching orders. It means making His vision our mission and making His mission our mission. He is the coach. We are His players and we may add, His *"prayers"* because without prayer, we cannot listen to His game plan.

There is one more thing that is required of a disciple: A joyful, grateful heart. Without joy, discipleship is just plain obligation. Without gratitude, discipleship is just duty. What Jesus is asking from a disciple is his/her very heart. God is not a user who just wants our service. He called us not just to do errands for Him, but to be one with Him.

I think there is no greater picture about true discipleship than that of the Blessed Mother. She literally followed her Son from the cradle to the grave and beyond. She not only served truly but she also loved deeply.

So, how about us? What kind of disciple are we? What should we do to be a real disciple as Jesus spoke about in today's Gospel, especially nowadays? *Fr. Aegi, SCJ*
