Solemnity of the Annunciation

We will have a special Mass to celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation on Monday April 8 at 7:00 pm. This feast was moved due to Holy Week. In this Mass, we will also include Prayers of Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary, as encouraged by Archbishop Leo at the request of the Holy Father, Pope Francis, who recently invited Catholics to annually renew an act of



consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Divine Mercy Sunday

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord Jesus called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know this feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina in April 2000. It points us to the merciful love of God that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery, – the passion, death, resurrection, and glorification of Christ, made present for us in the Eucharist.
