#### **CHRISTMAS GREETING**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate this fourth Sunday of Advent together, I wish to extend my pastoral greetings, blessings and prayers to each of you.

During the season of Advent, the church has called us to a time of waiting, watching and preparation for the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ. So often, these final days of Advent can become "Madvent" if we allow them to become consumed with shopping, baking, and other preparations for the festive season. We can easily lose sight of the inner meaning and reason for our celebration if we give in to the "madness" of commercialism and materialism. Even the singing of carols, the traditional meals, the family get- togethers and the loving exchange of gifts can obscure the deeper meaning of our Christmas festivities. As special as these experiences are, we are called to remember that beyond all of this good cheer, there is a great and Holy Mystery – the Word made flesh, Emmanuel – God with us, and among us, in our lives.

In the Gospel reading for this Sunday, St. Luke tells the story of the Annunciation, when Mary is visited by the Angel Gabriel. "Do not be afraid, Mary," the angel says, "for you have found favour with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. The angel reassures Mary and us that "nothing is impossible with God."

As we complete our final preparations for the Christmas feast, let us also hear and heed the voice of the angels and rejoice in the message that God is sending us. The virgin will bear a son who is our Lord and Saviour and he will save us from our sins and free us for lives of love, joy, and peace.

Amidst all the final shopping, baking, and meal preparations, let us take a few moments to ponder the meaning of the angel's words for us. They are words that invite us to receive the gift of God's love in Christ and to give it back to all those that we encounter in our lives.


