On Sunday (and its vigil, Saturday evening) the Church comes together to celebrate in word and eucharist, the mystery of our Lord's death and resurrection: the paschal mystery. Our celebration must include everyone: children and adults. Liturgy is praise and worship of God, the source and summit of the Church's life and our lives. At each weekend mass, children from Kindergarten to Gr. 4 are encouraged to participate in the Children's Liturgy of the Word, where the Gospel readings and reflection are adapted to a level in which they can fully, consciously and actively participate. The Word is proclaimed, a reflection follows, the Creed is professed and prayers of intercession are offered. Time for silence and stillness is given. Children's Liturgy of the Word is a reflection of the liturgy that takes place in the church and is meant to build up the members of Christ's body so that they may go out and proclaim Christ's love to others.






