BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

In an extremely dark time in Israel's history, when the kingdom was divided and many of the rulers corrupt and unjust, the prophet Isaiah arose and responded to God's call with a message of hope. Isaiah was the voice of God, urging the people to turn from their sinful ways and remain faithful to God, who would not abandon them. He foretold that God would bring salvation to Israel through the Messiah (Jesus). He spoke of the proclamation of the coming of the kingdom through John the Baptist: "A voice cries: In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God" (Isaiah 40:3). Ultimately he prophesied about the saving mission of Jesus: "He was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the punishment that made us whole, and by his bruises we are healed" (Isaiah 53:5). When we face difficult trials in our life, we must suffer with Jesus in bearing our cross, so that we may rise to new life through His resurrection.
