Stations of the Cross

During Lent, the Stations of the Cross will be celebrated at 7:00 p.m. each Friday evening followed by Mass.



Ash Wednesday is March 5, 2014 and marks the beginning of another Lenten season. We are graced by almighty God with another opportunity to turn away from sin and to follow more faithfully in the footsteps of Jesus Christ during these forty days of Lent. May God move our hearts to a greater spirit of love and sacrifice at this time.

Mass will be celebrated at 7:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses. Ashes achieve their meaning only when joined with our Lenten prayers, sacrifices and good works.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

People frequently ask about the discipline of penance at this time of the year. They should be helped to understand that all Christ's faithful are obliged by divine law to do penance, but certain days the Church prescribes that it must be done (Code Canon Law, canon 1249)

Abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence is to be observed on all Fridays throughout the year (Canon 1251). The law of abstinence forbids meat, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety. The law of fasting prescribes that only one meal is taken in a day; but it does not forbid taking some nourishment in the morning and evening.

The obligation to fast binds those between eighteen and sixty years of age. The law of abstinence pertains to everyone over fourteen (Canon 1252).

RCIA AND BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

Our RCIA catechumens have begun the next period in their Christian formation. They are dismissed at the 9 a.m. Mass after the homily every Sunday until their baptism. During this time they gather to break open God's word and grow in love and knowledge of God through the scriptures. Since they cannot yet join us at the Eucharistic table, they will be fed by God's word.

We, the baptized assembly, remain in the Mass to participate in the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and in our continued prayer for these catechumens, we sing a prayer to support them on their journey as they process out led by God's word.

May the Word of God strengthen you.

May the Word of God nourish you.

May the Word of God comfort you

All your life.
