WHY WE SAY THE NICENE CREED **DURING THIS YEAR OF FAITH**

We recite the Nicene Creed during this Year of Faith instead of the Apostles Creed, because the Nicene Creed is more expressive of the Church's understanding of the Blessed Trinity.

Particularly, the Nicene Creed expresses the fullness of Jesus Christ's Divinity and humanity, as well as our faith in the Holy Spirit as the giver of life and who is co-equal with the Father and the Son. The Nicene Creed further professes that the Father is Creator of all things both visible and invisible and that as a Church who professes the Triune God, we possess the forgiveness of sins and look forward to the life of the world to come.

PASTORAL REFERENCES
