BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP

Our Bible Study course "The Lamb's Supper" continues on Tuesday evenings at 7:15 p.m. in the parish hall.

Last Tuesday, we studied the various battles or wars described in the book of Revelation. We discussed the historical and spiritual significance they have. In a historical sense, these battles seem to point to the destruction of the Temple and City of Jerusalem in 70 AD. Spiritually, they can be interpreted as depicting the human struggle between good and evil.

The destruction of Jerusalem marks not just an ending, but a beginning, a renewed covenant between God and man. No longer would God's intimate presence be confined to a single sanctuary (the Jerusalem Temple). Now it would be everywhere, in His Church, where He abides in the Eucharist. This sacrament we celebrate as Jesus Christ's real presence. Jesus comes to us in the Mass, He remains with us in the Tabernacle.
