Ash Wednesday is February 10, 2016 and marks the beginning of another Lenten season. We are graced by almighty God with another opportunity to turn away from sin and to follow more faithfully in the footsteps of Jesus Christ during these forty days of Lent. May God move our hearts to a greater spirit of love and sacrifice at this time.

Mass will be celebrated at 7:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses. Ashes achieve their meaning only when joined with our Lenten prayers, sacrifices and good works.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

People frequently ask about the discipline of penance at this time of the year. They should be helped to understand that all Christ's faithful are obliged by divine law to do penance, but certain days the Church prescribes that it must be done (Code Canon Law, canon 1249)

Abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence is to be observed on all Fridays throughout the year (Canon 1251). The law of abstinence forbids meat, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety. The law of fasting prescribes that only one meal is taken in a day; but it does not forbid taking some nourishment in the morning and evening.

The obligation to fast binds those between eighteen and sixty years of age. The law of abstinence pertains to everyone over fourteen (Canon 1252).

PRAYER GROUP/BIBLE STUDY:

Lesson 5- Part D: A Throne for All Generations

Israel (The Northern Kingdom) had fallen and so did Judah (the Southern Kingdom) under King Hezekiah's son Manasseh, who built altars to false gods in the temple, "immolated his son by fire," and shed "so much innocent blood as to fill the length and breadth of Israel". The Babylonians overran Jerusalem crushing the city, destroying the temple, and sending thousands in exile.

In the exile, we read of the prophets Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Baruch and Daniel under the Babylonian King Nebuchadnezzar. Jeremiah prophesied that the exile in Babylon would last seventy years. King Cyrus of Babylon, issued an edict to let God's people return to Jerusalem and even helped fund the rebuilding of the Temple. The full story of the return of Judah and the restoration of Jerusalem is told in the Books of Ezra and Nehemiah:

- The Persian Empire was struck down by the Greeks in 331 BC under Philip of Macedonia and Alexander the Great.
 The Holy Land came under the control of a series of increasingly hostile kings
- Against all odds, the Maccabees, led by Judas Maccabeus and his brothers, ousted all foreign powers from Jerusalem
- The people were waiting on the promises of the Prophets who had taught Israel to hope for "a new David" -- their Saviour, their Messiah, "The "Anointed One"

Isaiah said that this son of David would be called "Wonder-Counsellor, God Hero, Father-Forever,Prince of Peace" and would reign "from David's throne...both now and forever." On the threshold of the New Testament, the devout and the righteous looked to these prophesies, awaiting the Consolation of Israel: the coming of the new son of David and the resurrection of his fallen Kingdom.
