R.C.I.A.

The Rite of Election is a special liturgical celebration at the beginning of Lent in which unbaptized catechumens (those preparing for initiation into the Church) enroll or write their names in a special "Book of the Elect" which is presented to the Bishop. The Catechumens from Our Lady of the World Parish will join catechumens from other parishes in the northern region on the First Sunday of Lent at St. Clare's Parish in Woodbridge to celebrate this rite. During this celebration, upon the testimony of sponsors and catechists and the catechumens' affirmation of their intention to join the Church, the Church makes its "election" of these catechumens to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist). In the presence of the bishop, they inscribe their names in the "Book of the Elect" as a pledge of fidelity. From then until their Baptism at Easter, they will be known as the "Elect". The Elect are those called by God to be his own, to be washed in the waters of Baptism, anointed by the Spirit in Confirmation, and nourished by Christ in the Eucharist. The Elect are chosen not simply for Baptism but for mission, Christ's mission. They are signs that God is still indeed with us, blessing our world and recreating it with his Spirit.

Lent is time of spiritual preparation for the Elect, and renewal and ongoing conversion for those already Baptized in anticipation of the celebration of Easter.

Ash Wednesday is on February 13, 2013 which marks the beginning of another Lenten season. We are graced by almighty God with another opportunity to turn away from sin, and to follow more faithfully in the footsteps of Jesus Christ during these forty days of Lent. May God move our hearts to a greater spirit of love and sacrifice at this time. We will be having Mass at 7:30a.m and 7:30 p.m. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses. Ashes achieve their meaning only when joined with our Lenten prayers, sacrifices and good works.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

People frequently ask about the discipline of penance at this time of the year. They should be helped to understand that all Christ's faithful are obliged by divine law to do penance, but there are certain days the Church prescribes that it must be done (Code Canon Law, canon 1249)

Abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence is to be observed on all Fridays throughout the year (Canon 1251). The law of abstinence forbids meat, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety. The law of fasting prescribes that only one meal is taken in a day; but it does not forbid taking some nourishment in the morning and evening.

The obligation to fast binds those between eighteen and sixty years of age. The law of abstinence pertains to everyone over fourteen (Canon 1252).
