## CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF CHILDREN WHO HAVE REACHED CATECHETICAL AGE

This form of the Rite of Christian Initiation is intended for children who have attained the use of reason and are of catechetical age. The child may already be baptized in the Catholic Church, or another Christian church, or not baptized at all.

The parish of Our Lady Queen of the World is inviting **children from Grade 6 to Grade 9** who are seeking to be fully initiated into the Catholic faith. At least one of the parents should be baptized and practicing Catholic who lives in the parish boundary as well as a member of Our Lady Queen of the World.

The Christian Initiation of these children requires both a conversion that is personal and somewhat developed, in proportion to their age, and the assistance of the education they need. Accordingly, their initiation is to be extended over several years, if need be, before they receive the sacraments.
