RCIA ~ WE CELEBRATE THE RITES OF ACCEPTANCE AND WELCOME

This weekend we meet the inquirers and the candidates who are journeying in this RCIA process towards full initiation and reception into the Church at Easter. We celebrate the first rites in this process together with them. At the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass we celebrate the Rite of Welcome (for those already baptised) and at the 9:00 a.m. Mass we celebrate the Rite of Acceptance (for those unbaptised).

During these special rites, the inquirers now become "Catechumens" and they, along with the candidates, are asked to give voice to their acceptance of the Gospel and to commit themselves to a journey of faith under the guidance of Christ. They share with us what they ask of God and of the Church. They are signed with the cross to show that they belong to Christ and that they are now called to learn to know him and follow him. As the baptised community, we are here to accept them and to welcome them. 




