Sunday of the Word of God

<u>Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter, Motu proprio "Aperuit illis"</u>, published in September 2019, establishes that "the **Third Sunday in Ordinary Time** is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God". Here are extracts from that Apostolic Letter:

Regular reading of sacred Scripture and the celebration of the Eucharist make it possible for us to see ourselves as part of one another. As Christians, we are people making our pilgrim way through history, sustained by the Lord, present in our midst, who speaks to us and nourishes us. We urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers. Sacred Scripture and the sacraments are thus inseparable. When the sacraments are introduced and illumined by God's word, they become ever more clearly the goal of a process whereby Christ opens our minds and hearts to acknowledge his saving work. Christ Jesus is knocking at our door in the words of sacred Scripture (Revelation 3:20). If we hear his voice and open the doors of our minds and hearts, then he will enter our lives and remain ever with us.
