## **PRAYER GROUP AND BIBLE STUDY** **THE RIGHTS AND WRONGS OF KINGS**

The establishment of the eternal kingdom of David is prepared by Samuel, the last of Israel's judges.

Samuel grows up to be a good and holy man who succeeds in turning "the whole Israelite population" back to the Lord. They aren't looking for a godly king, though. They want one "to lead us in warfare and fight our battles" (1 Samuel 8:19-20). They don't mention God or worship and they seem to have utterly forgotten Israel's original charter to be a holy, priestly people (Exodus 19:5-6). The Lord rejects Saul as king and dispatches Samuel to anoint a successor, "a man after (the Lord's) own heart"—David, son of Jesse, grandson of Ruth's son Obed, an anonymous shepherd boy living in Bethlehem. The Spirit of the Lord rushes upon David at his anointing (1 Samuel 16:13). He is anointed king by all the tribes of Israel and they call him God's chosen shepherd-king (2 Samuel 5:2). God makes His final covenant of the Old Testament with David. He promises to establish David's kingdom as an eternal and everlasting dynasty. He promises, too, that He will regard David's heir as His own son. Jesus talks about this covenant, saying that He himself is the fulfillment of that covenant: "I am the root and offspring of David: (Revelation 22:16).

The covenant with David furthers God's covenant plan by which all the world would be made children of Abraham, blessed and beloved sons and daughters of God (2 Kings 13:23; Psalm 102:45; Jeremiah 33:26). This covenant changes the character of God's covenant people from a nation state to that of an international kingdom. It is not only political and temporal, but spiritual and eternal. The king is not only human, but divine.

## **DESIGNATED CHURCHES FOR THE** **JUBILEE WITH A HOLY DOOR OF MERCY**

### **HOW TO OBTAIN THE JUBILEE INDULGENCE:**

Cardinal Collins has designated seven churches within the Archdiocese of Toronto as Jubilee Churches, each with a Holy Door of Mercy. Going through one of these Holy Doors is a spiritual journey that shows, as the Holy Father said, "the deep desire for true conversion." In addition to passing through a Holy Door, each pilgrim is to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, receive the Holy Eucharist while reflecting on God's great gift of mercy, make a profession of faith (recite either the Apostles' or the Nicene Creed), and pray for the Holy Father and for his intentions (an Our Father and a Hail Mary are recommended).
