Pope Francis' Canada visit (July 24 to 29)



Pope Francis' visit to Canada will primarily focus on Indigenous healing and reconciliation, while also providing the Pope with an opportunity to encounter the faithful in Canada. The Apostolic Journey will be focused on the theme "Walking Together", and will see the Pope hold various encounters with Indigenous peoples.

The Pope begins his visit in Edmonton, Alberta on July 24. Alberta is home to the largest number of former residential schools in Canada. Pope Francis will meet with Indigenous leaders and former residential school students from across the country on July 25. As the Church celebrates the feast of St. Anne, the grandmother of Jesus, on July 26, the Pope will celebrate an open-air Mass in Edmonton. St. Anne is particularly venerated by Indigenous Catholics. The Pope will also travel to Lac St. Anne, which tens of thousands of pilgrims visit each year.

After flying to Quebec on July 27, Pope Francis will meet with the Governor General and the Prime Minister. On July 28, the Pope will celebrate Mass at Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré, one of the oldest and most popular pilgrimage sites in North America. Over a million visitors travel there each year, including annual Indigenous pilgrimages. Pope Francis wraps up his visit to Canada with a stop in Iqaluit on July 29, where he will meet with Indigenous leaders and residential school survivors. Due to his advanced age and limitations, it is expected that the Pope's participation at public events will be limited.

Logo for Papal Visit unveiled

The Papal visit team unveiled the official logo of the Papal visit to Canada. The logo, which illustrates the "Walking Together" theme, is the work of an incredibly talented Indigenous artist, Shaun Vincent. "For this logo, community was at the heart of what I wanted to portray, with the caribou and bison herds, the fish and the eagles, with a dove of peace

and the Keys of St. Peter- representing the Holy Spirit and the Pope - set among the animals and elements of earth, sky and water. Wherever we go on this journey of healing and reconciliation, we go together.", explained Shaun Vincent.


