# Featured Saint

St. Mary Magdalene: Feast Day: July 22

Because Mary Magdalene was granted the privilege of announcing the Resurrection, she was given the title, "Apostle to the

Apostles." She thus became an inspiration to both her fellow disciples and to us today. The Gospels of Mark and Luke report that Mary was possessed of seven demons and that Jesus cast the demons out of her (Mark 16:9 and Luke 8:2). We don't know when Mary's discipleship began, but it's safe to assume that this miracle performed by Jesus had a profound effect on her life. It freed her of an unthinkable burden and left her with a deeply personal and unforgettable witness of Jesus' divine power, mercy, and kindness. Mary became a faithful disciple of Jesus. With the other women including Our Blessed Mother Mary, she stood by Jesus' Cross, brought spices to anoint His Body, and was the first witness to Jesus' Resurrection. She is the patron saint of penitent sinners and contemplative life.
