### MISSION APPEAL: AUGUST 5<sup>TH</sup> AND 6<sup>TH</sup>

Rev. Dominick Mbah will speak at all Masses about the works and needs of the Apostolic Vicariate of Bomadi in Nigeria, located in the rural areas of Delta State in the South-South of Nigeria. While the Catholic faith is thriving here and the harvest to God's Kingdom plentiful, the economic situation of the people of the Vicariate is, simply put, "deplorable." There is no access to clean water, roads, a hospital, schools or electricity. There are few jobs and the people depend on fishing as their main source of income. Waste is emptied into the River Niger, resulting in an abnormally high death rate especially among children, pregnant women, and the elderly. The Vicariate is undertaking a water project to help remedy this situation and to save lives lost to diseases caused by unclean water. The Vicariate also assists with feeding programmes, especially for school children and the elderly. Let us offer our prayerful and financial support to their urgent needs.

### **HEARING IMPAIRED ASSISTIVE LISTENING DEVICES coming this Fall**

We are happy to inform you that our parish has augmented its speaker systems and we will also be offering Assisted Listening Devices for you to hear the Mass more clearly, beginning September 9<sup>th</sup> 2017.

If you would like to use one of these devices, simply see an usher in the narthex to request one. If you already have a hearing aid or cochlear implant that is equipped with a T-Coil, you will not require the earpiece, only the transmitter. Before using this device with an implantable or other device, consult with your physician or manufacturer of the device. Always make sure you are using this product in accordance with the safety guidelines established by your physician or the manufacturer. To protect your hearing, make sure the volume is turned down before putting on the ear speaker or headphones, then adjust the volume to your preference. Children should be supervised when using this device.
