Saints of the Week St. Anne and St. Joachim: Feast: July 26 Joachim and Anne were the parents of Jesus' mother, Mary. We don't know many details about them because they are

not mentioned in the Bible. What we know about them comes down through tradition (the stories people told about them). We believe that they were respected members of the Jewish community. They wanted to become parents so much, that Joachim went into the desert to fast and pray that God would hear their prayer. It is said that an angel told them that they would soon have a daughter who would become famous throughout the world. Months later, Mary, our Blessed Mother, was born. When Mary was three years old, Anne and Joachim took her to the temple in Jerusalem to consecrate her for special service to the Lord. This celebration, the "Presentation of the Virgin Mary, shows the important role Mary would play in God's loving plan for the world. The beautiful shrine of Ste. Anne de Beaupre in Quebec, is devoted to St. Anne. St. Joachim and St. Anne are both patron saints of grandparents. St. Anne is patron saint of mothers, in particular expectant mothers and homemakers.
