NARTHEX UPDATE JUNE 2014

Well Rome was not built in a day and neither will the narthex that will someday certainly beautify our Church! You heard from us in November, 2013 that the building application process had begun and that we were required to complete a full site plan agreement (SPA) with the Town of Richmond Hill. That process continues to this day.

We have had several and ongoing discussions with the Town planners and various ministries both at the Region and at the Provincial level. We have had to make several sometimes difficult decisions regarding the size and shape of the narthex, the addition and deletion of various elements of the narthex as well as the surrounding areas. We have had to agree to dedicate lands to the Town, to make modifications to the existing building all in order to comply with the requirements of the Town and the various regional and provincial authorities so as to be able to obtain a SPA and ultimately a building permit.

We have been working at this since last summer and we are now imminently close to making a final submission to the Town that we are very optimistic will be successful.

We are very thankful for your continued support for, without it we could accomplish nothing. We have invested in some items for the new narthex and have net funds either on deposit or in outstanding pledges of approximately \$350,000.00 for this project. 
