

RCIA WE CELEBRATE THE SECOND SCRUTINY

We continue to journey with our elect as they prepare for Baptism at Easter. This Sunday, we



celebrate the Second Scrutiny at the 9am Mass. Once again, the community will be asked to pray that the elect be given a spirit of repentance and the true freedom of the children of God. May

God lead them to the kingdom of light through the gift of faith in Jesus, and free them from the false values that surround and blind them. May God set them firmly in his truth, children of the light forever.

REFLECTION ON THE 4TH SUNDAY OF LENT

The healing of the blind man helps us reflect on what conversion to Jesus Christ is.

First, CONVERSION BEGINS WITH GOD. The blind man did not initiate his healing, Jesus did. John, the apostle wrote: "In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to bear our suffering.

Second, CONVERSION INVOLVES FAITH. Jesus told the man born blind, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" and he did so, by faith, "and came back seeing." To have spiritual sight, we must respond to God's love in trust and faith.

Third, CONVERSION BEGINS A LIFE OF GREAT CHANGE. The word conversion means "to turn about, turn towards." The man born blind, just as the Samaritan woman at the well, turn away from their darkness toward the light of Christ and become children of the light. They bring the good news to others.
