BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

The people of Israel returned home, with God's help, following a long and difficult time in exile. This happened in three stages. Firstly, a group of people returned to rebuild the temple. Secondly, a group returned to re-establish the Word of God and teach it to the people. Thirdly, another group returned to build the walls of the city of Jerusalem. The building of the temple reinstated their place of worship and God's dwelling place among them. The reading and teaching of the Word of God enabled the people to align their lives to God's will. The walls of the city gave them security, stability, unity as a people and identity as a nation. In our modern lives, the temple is the Church, headed by Jesus – the Body of Christ. We ourselves must behave as temples of the Holy Spirit, making a dwelling place for God in our hearts. The Word of God nourishes, comforts, strengthens us and gives us a model for living.
