R.C.I.A The Scrutinies

We continue to pray for those enrolled in the RCIA process and preparing for initiation into the Church at Easter. Last week we heard how they presented their names to the Bishop and are now called, "The Elect", those who are chosen and called by God. They now enter into a period of this

initiation process called "Purification and Enlightenment". During this period we, as parish, celebrate special rites with them, called "Scrutinies" (penitential rites), which are celebrated on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent.

In the Scrutinies, the elect and the community acknowledge the powers of evil that weigh us down and divert us from the way of Christ. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal, all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good. The elect need to see how sin works in their own lives, in order to turn away from it, and walk into the light of Christ at Baptism.

On these three Sundays, we hear the readings from Year A which reflect the very purpose of the Scrutiny Rites. We see laying of hands upon the elect (a sign of healing). As parish community, we take part in this celebration, and although the community does not receive a laying on of hands, we are invited to take this time to examine our own lives and pray for healing and strength in Christ as well.

Please continue to pray for all those in the RCIA process during this period of intense preparation.




