PARISH LENTEN MISSION ~ COME TO ME AND I WILL GIVE YOU REST (MT. 11-28)


March 17, 18, 19th, 7:30 to 9:00 PM

MILK BAGS FOR HAITI ~ LIVING OUT OUR LENTEN PROMISE

Thanks to all parishioners who have been bringing in milk bags. Please continue to do so and, before bringing it to the church, please turn the bag inside-out, allowing it to air dry.

The milk-bag mats offer people without beds, a durable and washable alternative to sleeping on the cold, damp ground. They are also used by health care professionals as operating tables! The bags are ideal because they don't disintegrate, are strong, UV resistant, anti-bacterial, washable and colourful. It



takes approximately 400 milk bags to make an adult mat.

We are now ready to roll up our sleeves and make some mats!

<u>Cutting Day:</u> Join our parish family on Saturday, March 15th from 10 am to 2pm. We'll

begin with a brief training session then cut all the bags into weaving strips. Then, **on April 12th, from 10 am to 4 pm**, come back with your friends for our Weaving Day. With 4 or 5 people per loom, OLQW could make 20 -30 mats by the end of the day, ready for shipping! We're so grateful for the wonderful help of Carol Baptista's Gr. 9 class at Jean Vanier CHS who will be building the looms under the guidance of Angela Kesthely, the inspiration for the Milk Bag project.
