Ascension of the Lord

He is risen! He has ascended! He is with us! Alleluia! It may seem odd at first to put those exclamations together, but the truth is that they are all united in a line of thought. There would be no Christians if Jesus had not risen from the dead. The resurrection of Christ is the foundation of our faith. His rising from the tomb gives us the promise of new life since through his resurrection he has conquered sin and broken the chains of death. His ascension to the right hand of the Father is a sign of hope for us all. As the preface to the Eucharistic prayer for this day says: Christ "has passed beyond our sight, not to abandon us but to be our hope? [W]here he has gone, we hope to follow" (P 26). But he is still with us, through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, the gift poured out on all the baptized. As the alternate preface for today states, "In his risen body [Christ] plainly showed himself to his disciples and was

taken up to heaven in their sight to claim for us a share in his

divine life" (P 27). Christ is with us through the divine life that




