

The Archdiocese has established a protocol that ensures accountability and prevents potential conflicts of interest. General contractors may submit a completed CCDC Document 11 for consideration by the architect to be included in the pre-qualified list of bidders for the Sub-trades, suppliers, wholesalers, and project. manufacturers may submit their names along with the products/service they provide. They will be provided a list of the general contractors so that they may review the drawings and elect to submit a bid for their portion of the work. All submissions should be made directly to the parish secretary to ensure proper re-distribution to the appropriate party. We thank you for your interest and cooperation.
