CAMPAIGN REFLECTION

In these first weeks of spring time in Richmond Hill, we are reminded of one of the deepest meanings of the Easter season – that Christ is risen from the dead and through our faith in him, we are also given the gift of new life. As we enjoy the blossoming of the buds in our gardens and the greening of our trees, the warmth of the sunshine and the lengthening days, it's hard not to feel gratitude and even wonder at the way in which the gift of new life is literally rising around us in God's creation.

The launching of the Capital Campaign in this anniversary year is also a sign of new life in our parish. As we launch this building campaign, let us give thanks that He is truly "making all things new" in our parish. Let us open our hearts and join Him in this work of the Spirit, supporting it with all of the time, talent and treasure that we can offer. And let us trust that we will be given all that we need by God to realize Christ's mission in the Church and the world.
